Mayor Nix Called for Committee Reports:

Mayor Nix called on Council Member King for Public Health and Safety Reports. Council Member King called on Chief Littleton for the Police Department Report. Chief Littleton reported there were 90 Reports for July and 604 Total Cases for the Year. See Appendix 1.

Council Member King called on Chief Davis for the Fire Department report. Chief Davis reported that there were 126 Calls for the month of July and 887 Total Calls for the Year. See Appendix 2.

Council Member King reported Planning & Zoning Meeting will be held Thursday, August 1st at 6pm here at City Hall and the meeting is open to the public.

Mayor Nix called for the Sustainability Reports. Mayor Nix called on Council Member Dukes. Council Member Dukes called on Kirk Hamby, Director of Public Works. Kirk reported paving will begin tomorrow; new stage in Orr Park to be completed this week; trees down in several areas around town/mostly large oaks due to hollowing inside and department will be working to clear.

Council Member Dukes reported there would be a Historical Preservation Commission meeting coming up soon.

Mayor Nix called for Recreation, Preservation and Community Development. Council Member Eisenberg called on Sydney Aguilar-Baugh, Director Youth Sports. Sidney reported tomorrow they have a meet the Bulldogs at 6pm; Thursday from 4pm - 7pm is registration for Fall sports at City Hall; Flag Football has started, and the young team won their first game.

Council Member Eisenberg has received complaints about animals running free in neighborhoods. Mayor Nix reminded everyone there is a leash law for pets.

Mayor Nix called for the Education, Arts & Outreach Reports. Mayor Nix called on Marissa Wilson, Director Parnell Memorial Library. Marissa reported they have 39 programs running in July; there have been 4,965 visits to the building; 1,787 program participation; 77 community meetings. See Appendix 3.

Mayor Nix reported Sarah Hogan Shaw, Program Director, Impact Montevallo is out of town and couldn't attend the meeting. No written report submitted.

Mayor Nix called on Mary Elizabeth House for the MJCC report. Mary Elizabeth thanked everyone that participated and attended the MJCC Candidate Forum to make it a success; they will be starting interviews for MJCC soon; first MJCC meeting will be next Monday; meet the Bulldogs tomorrow at 6pm; Jamboree game against West Blocton is this Thursday at home; first football game will be next Thursday; first Volleyball game will be on August 23rd; Homecoming game is September 12th; Tim Tingle is carving a new Bulldog at the front of the high school.

Mayor Nix called on Council Member Swords for Finance, Economic Development & Tourism. Council Member Swords reported Adele Nelson, Executive Director, Montevallo Chamber of Commerce submitted a written report due to the Chamber hosting the Montevallo Farmers' Market on Mondays until August 18th; the Chamber is providing five "Welcome Bags" for the incoming University of Montevallo new faculty members; August 20th is the Chamber Luncheon and the topic is "Back to School" with speakers from Montevallo Elementary, Middle, and High Schools; UM Community Night at Men's Soccer Field behind the Student Activity Center will feature food trucks, games, and contests - flyer behind report. Resolution 08112025-500

A Resolution Authorizing BFI Waste Services, LLC dba: Republic Services of Birmingham to Administer Solid Waste Collection and Disposal in the City of Montevallo, Alabama

WHEREAS, the Montevallo City Council has determined it serves a public purpose for the City of Montevallo to enter into a contract for the purpose of administering solid waste collection and disposal for the City of Montevallo, Alabama. and,

WHEREAS, the City of Montevallo recognizes that it is wise and desirable that adequate provision be made for regular and efficient collection of garbage and domestic rubbish (as defined in Solid Waste Act. No 771 as enacted into law by the 1969 Legislature, and as amended, and termed refuse in the Shelby County Board of Health regulations governing the collection, storage, transferring and disposing of solid waste) in certain areas within the jurisdiction of the City in order that the health of the citizens of the City be protected and the general welfare of the City be advanced; and

WHEREAS, the Contractor hereby applies to the City for a franchise in the exclusive residential collection and transportation to a disposal facility of such refuse, garbage, and domestic rubbish within the corporate limits of Montevallo; and

WHEREAS, the City hereby grants this requested franchise under the authority of the statutes of the State of Alabama, Solid Waste Act No. 771 as enacted into law by the 1969 Legislature, and as amended; and

WHEREAS, BFI Waste Services, LLC dba: Republic Services of Birmingham was the lowest responsible bidder in accordance with The Competitive Bid Law, Sections 41-16-50 through 41-16-63, Code of Alabama 1975 via a sealed bid opened in a public meeting on August 1, 2022, and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to City of Montevallo Resolution 09122022-500, BFI Waste Services, LLC dba: Republic Services of Birmingham was authorized to perform the solid waste collection, disposal and treatment, including residential garbage, (trash), within the corporate limits of the City of Montevallo, Alabama for a period not to exceed three (3) years, beginning October 1, 2022 and ending September 30, 2025 and

WHEREAS, the City of Montevallo and BFI Waste Services, LLC dba: Republic Services of Birmingham mutually agree to a renewal of the terms and conditions, without change or alteration, of the contract attached hereto as Exhibit A and,

WHEREAS, the State of Alabama Attorney General in AGO-1996-142 stated that "a municipality may renew an existing solid waste disposal contract without taking bids, if the material terms of the contract are not changed" and

WHEREAS, the City of Montevallo shall provide leaf, limb, and yard debris collection and disposal as a separate service to its residents and,

WHEREAS, the City of Montevallo shall provide recycling services at its facility located at 1120 Overland Road as a separate service for its residents,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONTEVALLO, ALABAMA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Council of the City of Montevallo, Alabama finds that it is wise, expedient, and necessary that BFI Waste Services, LLC dba: Republic Services of Birmingham administer the solid waste collection, disposal and treatment on behalf of its residents in accordance with Solid Waste Disposal Act, Code of Ala. 1975, § 22-27-1 et seq.; local solid waste management programs required, Code of Ala. 1975, § 22-27-47 and in accordance with the Municipal Code of the City of Montevallo, Chapter 18: Solid Waste, Sections 18-1 through 18-52, subject to the limitations and conditions in substantial form as attached hereto in Exhibit A.

Section 2. That pursuant to this Resolution, BFI Waste Services, LLC dba: Republic Services of Birmingham shall be authorized to perform the solid waste collection, disposal and treatment, including residential garbage, (trash), within the corporate limits of the City of Montevallo, Alabama for a period not to exceed three (3) years, beginning October 1, 2025 and ending September 30, 2028.

Section 3. That the City of Montevallo Public Works Department shall provide leaf, limb, and yard debris collection and disposal as a separate service to its residents.

Section 4. That the City of Montevallo Public Works Department shall provide recycling services for plastics, paper, cardboard and aluminum in a single stream recycling compactor located at its facility at 1120 Overland Road as a separate service for its residents.

Section 5. That rates for solid waste collection, disposal and treatment, leaf, limb, and yard debris collection and disposal, and recycling services be billed to residents in the amount of Thirty-three (33) dollars and fifty cents, per residence as set forth in Exhibit A, and that the Montevallo Water and Sewer Board is authorized to bill and collect said fees as set forth in Exhibit A, on behalf of the City of Montevallo, effective October 1, 2025.

Section 6. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon publication hereof as provided by law.
