Minutes

Meeting was called to order at 6:34 p.m.

Old Business

The minutes from the February 7, 2017 meeting were read. A motion was made by S. Vallides to accept the minutes as presented; S. Godwin seconded; motion passed.

J. Seaman welcomed new members, S. Godwin and B. Glosson, to the MHPC. Both members have been officially approved by the City Council.

Archeological Survey Project at Mahler Property Update: The Archeological study has been completed by Bonnie Gumm. MHPC members were not informed of the dig in a timely manner for participation. MHPC will attempt to work closely with the Alabama State Historic Commission to validate current and correct contact information for future notifications. Ms. Gumm will send a detailed report after artifacts that were discovered on the property are dated.

The MHPC currently have two inactive members (J. Lott and H. Emfinger). J. Seaman asked members to be thinking of persons with a love of Montevallo history for future nominations. The MHPC would like to make an effort to insure that the Commission has a diverse representation of all communities within the city.

J. Seaman reported that informational signage for Mahan Park and Shoal Creek Park have not been ordered.

Bicentennial Committee Update: Banners are still for sale for \$200. Bicentennial project for March is citywide trash pickup. Citizens will meet at 9:00 a.m. at City Hall each Saturday of the month. A historic bike-a-thon will take place on April 29th has been added as part of the bicentennial celebration. Notecards have been reordered and will continue to be for sale. A "Bicentennial Bash" has been planned for September 9th at Orr Park.
