Quorum was met and the meeting was called to order at 6:00 PM

James Salter made the motion to approve the minutes from the October 7th meeting as read; Melinda Nix seconded; motion passed.

James Salter reported that the Prentice high School historical marker has been received by the city of Montevallo. A date and time for installation of the marker will be announced when definite plans have been made. It was also announced that the marker installation ceremony for Almont Elementary School was well attended.

M. Nix informed the commission that the city has approved for the Montevallo Historical Society to have a 30-year lease and begin preserving the Mahler house.

M Nix asked members to submit their professional development reports.

The Commission welcomed a special guest to tonight's meeting, Kathy King, representative from the Montevallo Legacy Project. Dr. King presented the commission with an informational package regarding the placing of the Shoal Creek Baptist Church cemetery on the National Register. The Shoal Creek Baptist meeting house was recognized as a division from the Cahaba Valley Baptist Church. It has been established that the cemetery is on city property Dr. King stated that she is looking forward to further funding for the cemetery. It was suggested that the graves not be marked and not try to fence the cemetery because it could cause maintenance issues. It is planned to have signage at the parking lot with information and directions to the cemetery for visitors. The request is to send the request to the city for funding uses of the grant that has been approved.

Bill Glosson made a motion to send a recommendation to the City Council to approve the marker for Shoal Creek Baptist Church cemetery; motion seconded by James Salter; motion approved.
