- Lelia presented a draft program. She will send out her updated copy ASAP.
 - Dance performance will be from local group that performed at Pecan Grove last year (secured by Lelia).
 - Music from UM Gospel Choir (secured by Lelia).
 - Other ideas: MHS Jazz Band to play, perhaps while people are eating? (Dr. Courtney will reach out.)
 - Courtney will ask Sarah if we can borrow Impact's sound system.
 - Dr. Courtney will reach out to Maxine Morgan about reading poetry.
 - Lelia will ask Lisa Shapiro to create proclamations honoring Good Shepherd Funeral Home and It's About Time Barber Shop.
- Lunch:
 - MAC may not be doing butts this year, so Cliff has reached out to Brother Paul's BBQ in Alabaster, and he quoted \$500. Cliff will follow up. Ladies at the church will assemble again. Dr. Courtney will get buns/bulk chips/dessert/waters/soft drinks/napkins/larger lunch sacks/bbq sauce if needed from Costco again. Make sure to get a lot of water. Will prepare 150 meals. Dr. Courtney will talk to Adele from Montevallo Chamber about potential water/coke donation.
 - To pay vendors from the Parks & Rec City budget, an invoice (without sales tax) needs to be given to Sharon Williams at City Hall.
 - Will need coolers. Dr. Courtney will ask Adele about this and all the other items.
 - Lelia will provide lemonade.
 - Monetary donations towards the food:
 - Cliff and one other business person would like to donate; Kathy has submitted a donation too. Parks & Rec budget will cover whatever balance remains.
- Setup/logistics:
 - Talk to Adele if we need to borrow chairs/tables/tents. Dr. Courtney will talk to her.
 - Cliff recommends borrowing 40 folding chairs, 6 tables (2 for food, 1 for MLP, 1 for Children's Activities, 2 extra), 2 tents (one for over food and one extra, possibly for MLP to use)
