Hello, all! As an update for those who were not able to make it to the meeting on Monday, to which I was invited as a guest (this is Courtney BENNETT!), the Board decided to hold the event on June 19 at Dailey Park from 10 AM - 1 PM. Therefore, DRUM the Program will not be able to perform since they are not available that day. I emailed Elvie about that but she has not yet responded (they were only available June 15). Cliff is looking into other performer options, including poetry and step. Any suggestions are welcome. Montevallo Main Street is willing to sponsor performances up to \$500.

In order to raise funds to cover the cost of food that will be given out at the event, the Board is soliciting 10 sponsorships for \$50 each. Montevallo Main Street has agreed to be the fiscal agent for the Parks & Rec Board to streamline the donation collection process.
