

Starting a Business in Montevallo

1. Study the local market—can Montevallo support your business idea?

- a. Review the Economic Development page on the City's website.
- b. Review the <u>2017 Market Study</u> and <u>Market Profile</u> commissioned by Montevallo Main Street.
- c. Contact <u>58 INC</u>, Shelby County's economic development organization.
- d. Contact Montevallo Chamber of Commerce.
- e. Contact <u>Montevallo Main Street</u>, especially if you'd like to start your business downtown.

2. Create your Business Plan.

- a. See the Small Business Administration's guidance on writing a business plan.
- b. Contact Alabama Small Business Development Network for assistance.

3. Choose your Business Structure (Sole Proprietorship, Partnership, Corporation, S Corporation, Limited Liability Company, etc.)

- a. Review the IRS' guidance on starting a small business.
- b. Visit the Alabama Secretary of State website.

4. Identify Business Location.

- a. Contact Montevallo Chamber of Commerce for assistance in any area.
- b. Contact Montevallo Main Street for assistance in the downtown area.

5. Zoning Verification and Building Permits.

- a. Schedule meeting with Montevallo City Clerk, <u>Herman Lehman</u>, to verify the zoning and permitted land uses of your prospective location and to discuss building permits for any potential renovations. All renovations must meet the current building code.
- If your business location is in the Urban Core or Scenic Corridor Overlay
 District, your renovations and signage will be subject to review by the Design Review Committee.

6. Building Inspection.

a. Schedule building inspection from <u>Shelby County Development Services</u> at least 3 weeks prior to the date you plan to open your business. Your building inspection must be complete and final before you can proceed to the next step.

7. Fire Inspection.

a. Schedule fire inspection from Montevallo Fire Department at least 2 weeks prior to the date you plan to open your business. All building inspections must be complete and final, per Shelby County Development Services, before a fire

inspection can be conducted. To request a fire inspection, review the <u>Pre-Inspection Checklist</u> and submit a <u>Request for Fire Inspection Form</u>.

8. Health Department.

a. Schedule health department inspection, if applicable to your business type, at least 2 weeks in advance of your opening date.

9. Purchase business license from City Hall.

a. Please note: Before a business license can be issued, you MUST have a complete and final building inspection and fire inspection, and a health department inspection (if applicable).

10. Open for business!
